

TOWN OF UNIONVILLE MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

The Town Council of the Town of Unionville met at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, August 18, 2014 in Town Hall, 1102 Unionville Church Road, Monroe, NC. Mayor Simpson and Commissioners Randy Baucom, Edd Little and Jaren Simpson were present. Town Attorney Ken Helms was also present. Commissioners Ken Brown and Robert Crouch were absent. Town Budget and Finance Officer Darrell Baucom was also absent.

Everyone stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag. Mayor Simpson led the prayer of invocation.

Mayor Simpson called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone present. There were no public comments.

There being no corrections to the minutes of the July 21, 2014 regular meeting, Mayor Simpson declared them approved as reviewed by Council.

There being no questions regarding the Financial Statements, and upon motion duly made by Edd Little, seconded by Jaren Simpson, Council unanimously approved payment of pending bills.

Mayor Simpson recognized resident Mrs. Michele Sarno. Mrs. Sarno reported that she recently attended a meeting regarding Union County Parks and Recreation's master plan. Union County is interested in what towns have and what they need for parks and greenways. She requested that the Town Council appoint a Parks and Recreation Committee for Town of Unionville, as all previous members' terms have expired. If the Town has a solid plan, Union County will partner with the towns and will have a better chance to receive grants. Clerk Gaddy shared the names of the previous committee. Attorney Helms suggested that the Council appoint the committee with staggered three-year terms. Upon motion duly made by Jaren Simpson, seconded by Randy Baucom, Council unanimously appointed Scott Barbee and Darrell Baucom to a one-year term; Tim Black, John Fagala and Kevin Little to a two-year term and Eric Purser, Michele Sarno and Brendan Sheprow to a three-year term. This leaves one vacant seat. The consensus of the Council is to advertise for applicants on the Town website. Mrs. Sarno will contact the members and arrange a meeting, at which time the committee will elect their own chairman.

The next item of business was to consider the Dave Smith Tree Experts quote to complete the tree-trimming at Unionville Community Center and the lot across Unionville Indian Trail Road. After some discussion, Council asked Jerry Hinson to meet with Dave Smith and submit another proposal.

Mayor Simpson read and signed the Constitution Week Proclamation. It will be displayed in Town Hall during the month of September.

Clerk Gaddy reminded Council that Scott Barbee had requested the Town to install two spigots on the front of Town Hall to water shrubs along the front wall. The consensus of the Council was to have Mike Rushing install these spigots.

Mr. Ken Kiser reported that the map and final paperwork for Annexation #20 will be presented at the September 15, 2014 regular meeting. Commissioner Randy Baucom made inquiry as to the number of households in the annexation. Mr. Kiser reported that there are approximately 60 homes that reach from the existing town limits on Morgan Mill Road down Old Camden Road and south onto Olive Branch Road—a span of four miles.

There being no other business, Mayor Simpson declared the meeting adjourned.
