

**TOWN OF UNIONVILLE
MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Town Council of the Town of Unionville held a public hearing on Monday, January 19, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. in Town Hall, 1102 Unionville Church Road, Monroe, NC. The purpose of the hearing was to hear public comments regarding Annexation #20, several parcels on Old Camden Road and Olive Branch Road. Mayor Simpson and Commissioners Randy Baucom, Ken Brown, Edd Little and Jaren Simpson were present. Commissioner Robert Crouch was absent. Town Attorney Ken Helms was also present.

Mayor Simpson called the public hearing to order and welcomed everyone attending.

Clerk Sonya Gaddy introduced the annexation, stating that this voluntary annexation covers approximately 1,300 acres down Old Camden Road and Olive Branch Road. She has worked with the petitioners for several months now, and certifies that everything is in order. An advertisement of this public hearing ran in the Enquirer-Journal on Fridays, January 9 and 14, 2015.

Mr. Ken Kiser thanked Nelda Lemmond and Carroll Rushing for all of their work on this annexation. It took more work than he had thought it would. He wants to bring this property to Unionville; they feel like they are Unionville, and they want to be a part of Unionville. The population is continually increasing; there are babies being born and folks moving in. There are four houses under construction and several will be started this spring. He respectfully asks for the Board to consider making this a part of the Town.

There being no other comments, Mayor Simpson declared the public hearing adjourned.
