

**TOWN OF UNIONVILLE
MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The flood insurance public hearing for the purpose of hearing public comments regarding Text Amendment ZC-09-03 to Land Use Ordinance Article XVI: Floodplains, Drainage, Stormwater Management to reflect the NC Model Ordinance language to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program was held June 15, 2009 at 7:15 p.m. in Town Hall, 1102 Unionville Church Road, Monroe, NC.
