

**TOWN OF UNIONVILLE
MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The 2009-2010 budget public hearing for the Town of Unionville was held June 15, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in Town Hall, 1102 Unionville Church Road, Monroe, NC. Mayor Simpson and Commissioners Jim Baucom, Robert Croutch and Edd Little were present. Commissioners Randy Baucom and Ken Brown were absent. Town Attorney Ken Helms was also present.

Mayor Simpson called the public hearing to order and welcomed everyone.

Resident Arlie Rushing addressed Council on behalf of the Unionville Community Center. He stated that the Board would like to request some money to help them pave the parking lot and build a bandstand roof prior to the July 4th festivities. If this is not something the Council can do at this time, he would like to be on the agenda for next month's meeting.

Budget and Finance Officer Darrell Baucom stated that there have been a few changes to the budget since he distributed it to Council last. The zoning estimate was \$30,000 and the estimate from Centralina Council of Governments is \$39,700, so we should increase the budget. Also, previously he had estimated \$10,000 for liability insurance, and the quote from North Carolina League of Municipalities is \$9,132. The current carrier is non-renewing our insurance due to the Griffin Farms and Landfill claims. These are the only two potential adjustments that might need to be made.

There being no other comments, Mayor Simpson declared the public hearing adjourned.
